

Malaysia Budget Program



Day 1: AUSTRALIA – KUALA LUMPUR – MALACCA

Please meet at the airport for your flight to Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. Upon arrival in Kuala Lumpur you will be met and transferred to Malacca. This afternoon you will then enjoy a historical guided tour of Malacca. You will visit the Stadhuys which is believed to be the oldest Dutch building in the East and was the residence for the Dutch Governors, it also houses the Malacca historical museum. Your guide will take you to the Portuguese Settlement, here you can visit the many restaurants, and souvenir stalls and the lanes where people live all named in Portuguese.

Day 2: MALACCA -KUALA LUMPUR (B)

This morning after breakfast you will enjoy the Animal safari and Waterworld. At the safari you will see more than 150 different species including lions, tigers, zebras, giraffes and much more. You will explore the habitat on safari trucks, experience the animals up close in the walk through area, and cruise to Monkey Island on a raft and many more exciting activities. You will then enjoy all the fun at Waterworld with rides such as the seven storey high speed slide and the longest Lazy River in the world. Late this afternoon you will depart Malacca for Kuala Lumpur and be transferred to your hotel.

Day 3: KUALA LUMPUR – TAMAN NAGARA – KUALA LUMPUR (B)

This morning after breakfast you will travel by coach to the Kuala Gandah Elephant Conservation Sanctuary. Here you will be able to come into contact with semi- wild elephants. You will also have the chance to enjoy elephant rides, feeding the elephants and watch them bathe in the river. This afternoon you will travel back to your hotel by coach.

Day 4: KUALA LUMPUR – BATU CAVES – KUALA LUMPUR (B)

This morning after breakfast you will enjoy a full day Kuala Lumpur city tour including a visit to the Batu Caves. You will have the opportunity to visit the Independence square which is dominated by the flagpole which commemorates the countries independence. You will also visit the King`s Palace, National Museum, and the Patronas Towers where you can enjoy a panoramic view of the city. The group will then have an opportunity to see the Malaysian Handicraft on display at the Craft Centre. This afternoon you will continue onto visit the Batu Caves, the caves are a sacred place for Hindu's where once a year the Thaipusam festival is celebrated. The limestone caves were discovered in 1892 and consist of 3 main caves connected with 272 steps from the foothill. This evening you will visit Chinatown, this bustling market is a bargain hunters paradise and has a distinctly oriental atmosphere.

Day 5: KUALA LUMPUR – BUKIT GANTING (BLD)

This morning after breakfast you will depart Kuala Lumpur for your homestay in Bukit Gantang. Upon arrival you will meet your host families, lunch and dinner today will be at the homestay.

You will stay with a Malaysian family and live the life as the local people do including staying in a wooden house and dining on local dishes prepared by the hosts.

Day 6: BUKIT GANTING (BLD)

After breakfast this morning you will visit the fruit farm, the farm is surrounded by traditional orchids and lush tropical rainforests. You will taste the tropical fresh fruits and walk through the beautiful area. You will then visit the Historical site the Kota Long Jafaar. Kota Ngha Ibrahim Historical Complex is situated in Matang and was built in 1854. Over the years it has served as various establishments such as Larut Administration Centre, as a court for the prosecution of Dato' Maharajalela Lela and Dato' Sagor for the killing of J.W.W. Birch, as the residence for Captain Speedy the assistant Resident, the first Teacher's Training College and the First National School, Matang Primary School. Lunch and dinner today will be with your host families.

Day 7: BUKIT GANTING – KUALA LUMPUR – AUSTRALIA (B)

This morning after breakfast you will say goodbye to your host families and travel back to Kuala Lumpur. Upon arrival into Kuala Lumpur you will be transferred to the airport for your international flight back to Australia.

Day 8: AUSTRALIA

Arrive home.

INCLUSIONS:

- Return international economy airfare Australia / Kuala Lumpur / Australia.
- Accommodation: based on students in twin share, staff in a twin room.
- 1 night Malacca, 3 nights Kuala Lumpur, 2 nights Bukit Gantang (homestay).
- Meals: as per itinerary (B= breakfast, L= lunch, D= Dinner).
- Guided tours: half-day tour of Malacca and full day tour of Kuala Lumpur including Batu Caves and Chinatown.
- Entrance fees: Cowboy town, Waterworld and Animal Safari, Elephant Sanctuary.
- Coach travel and transfers as per itinerary.
- Local office in Malaysia.
- Trekset travel wallets.
