

European Experience



Day 1: **Australia–London**
Depart Australia.

Day 2: **London**
Transfer by coach to your hotel.

Day 3: **London** **(B)**
Free day for sightseeing in London: visit such sights as Buckingham Palace and Piccadilly Circus, and the London Eye.

Day 4: **London** **(B)**
Make your own way to Buckingham Palace for the “Changing of the Guard”. You can visit the British Museum, Trafalgar Square or a live theatre production.

Day 5: **London – Paris** **(B)**
Coach transfer from the hotel to the Waterloo train station for the Eurostar to Paris (2nd class one way). Upon arrival in Paris you are met by your coach and transferred to your hotel.

Day 6: **Paris** **(B)**
Discover Ile de la Cite and the Latin Quarter. You could also visit the Louvre Museum, stroll down the Champs Elysees or cruise on the River Seine.

Day 7: **Paris – Versailles – Paris** **(B)**
Travel by RER (round trip ticket included) to Versailles and visit Chateau de Versailles.

Day 8: **Paris – Neunkirchen** **(B)**
Your coach will arrive to collect your bags and take you to Euro Disney. Late this afternoon, depart for Neunkirchen- Furpach.

Day 9: **Neunkirchen – Speyer** **(B)**
Depart for Speyer by coach. This is one of the oldest cities of the Holy Roman Empire, with the largest Romanesque church in Europe.

Day 10: **Speyer – Rothenburg O.D. Tauber** **(B)**
Depart for Rothenburg via Heidelberg by coach, which is home of the oldest German University. Then proceed to Rothenburg OB Der Tauber, unchanged since the sixteenth century.

Day 11: **Rothenburg – Salzburg** **(B)**
Travel by coach to Salzburg. Stroll through the famous gardens where the scenes of “The Sound of Music” were filmed or visit the Mozart museum.

Day 12: **Salzburg - Venice** **(B)**
Depart for Venice by coach. Travel through the spectacular Dolomities and stop for lunch at Cortina D’Ampezzo.

Day 13: **Venice** **(B)**
Today you can visit: San Marco, Doges Palace, and The Basilica. This afternoon begin your 2 - day ferry pass, where you can visit either islands of Burano or Murano.

Day 14: **Venice** **(B)**
Groups own arrangements for sightseeing, using the ferry pass. You can visit the neighbouring islands of Lido and Torcello.

Day 15: **Venice – Florence** **(B)**
Depart Venice for Florence, en-route you will stop in Pisa to see the Leaning Tower.

Day 16: **Florence** **(B)**
Today you can visit: Piazza della Signoria, the famous Uffizzi Gallery, The Ponte Vecchio, or Piazza Michelangelo for the best view of the town.

Day 17: **Florence – Rome** **(B)**
Depart Florence by coach. The day is then free to explore the city; you can visit the Forum and Colosseum.

Day 18: **Rome** **(B)**
Today you can visit: The Vatican City and see St Peter's Basilica and the Sistine Chapel.

Day 19: **Rome – Pompeii – Sorrento** **(B)**
Depart Rome for your day trip to Pompeii. Also visit Sorrento, where you will have lunch overlooking the bay of Naples.

Day 20: **Sorrento – Capri – Rome** **(B)**
Depart Sorrento for Naples by coach. Take a ferry to the Isle of Capri. Catch your ferry back to Naples where you will be met by your coach captain and then be transferred to Rome.

Day 21: **Rome – Australia** **(B)**
Transfer by coach to Rome airport for your flight back to Australia.

Day 22: **Australia**
Arrive Home.
